### Background History of the Region

Education College is situated at a Village & Post Office Basantapur-742406, District Murshidabad of West Bengal. This District is very backward in education. The number of Secondary Schools, Higher Secondary Schools, and colleges are much less than required. There is no University in the district. This district has the distinction of housing, the maximum number of Muslims a district has in India. Almost all of them are backward – both educationally and economically.

Basantapur Education Society (Which is Managing the Education College) was established in 1995 under West Bengal Societies Registration Act 1961, vide Registration No S/80709 of 1995-96, keeping in view in meeting the needs and demands of the knowledge seekers of the communities of Basantapur area and the district of Murshidabad in particular and the rest of West Bengal and India as a whole in general.

Basantapur Education Society which is the Brain Child of the Son of the Soil, Litterateur and Social Worker Dr Nazrul Islam, B Sc, M A, M B A, Ph D, D Litt and I P S (Former). His dynamic leadership and quality of thoughts and aspirations acted behind the screen of the Foundation of this Society. With a group of enthusiastic well-wishers and social workers of this locality.

It can also be said that the Basantapur Education Society (BES) is the outcome of Dr Islam's childhood experiences and hardships in education and dreams of quality of education which drove him out from this remote and educationally backward areas to the great Kolkata Urban Metropolis in search of higher and proper education.

## Education College

The establishment and management of the schools and colleges convinced the management of the BES, the urgent necessity of the Teacher Education. Hence Education College was established in 2007 to run B Ed courses. It was immediately felt that, it was more difficult to find Teacher-Educators, who are very less in number in the State, and almost absent in the region. Hence the management of the institution started M Ed. with permission from NCTE and Affiliation of University of Kalyani, in 2009. Though situated in such a remote village, the students, teachers & managerial team of this college are always concerned to ensure both quality and quantity dimension of education.
